"Stand at the crossroads, and look, and ask for the ancient paths." Jeremiah 6:16

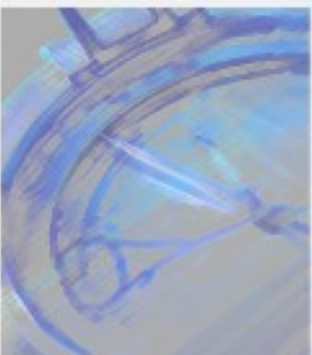
*"In the bleak midwinter, frosty wind made moan,

I already know—because you've told me in no uncertain terms—that it's not your favorite hymn. But to me, "In the Bleak Midwinter" is a beautiful embrace of what might otherwise be a brutal season. Call it what it is. Name it. Claim it. Bleak, midwinter. This most recent winter storm was a fresh reminder of the sentiment expressed in word and song: frosty wind made moan. I certainly heard it in my home, as you probably did.

But we can thank this season for what it does for us. It sends us inside and inward. We have to go within to survive. And going inward, helps us thrive spiritually. This going inward to grow spiritually reminds me of the words of another writer who said, "*I had always imagined God to be in the same general direction as everything else that I valued: up. I had failed to appreciate the meaning of some words that had intrigued me since I first heard them in seminary—Tillich's description of God as the 'ground of being.'*" I had to be forced underground before I could understand that the way to God is not up but down." (Parker Palmer)

Our invitation to journey together doesn't include the invitation to go downward. But maybe it should, along with winter's invitation to go within is the invitation to get in touch with what grounds us and keeps us stable, firm and rooted. May this season find you still, silent, and pondering your inner strength and truth.

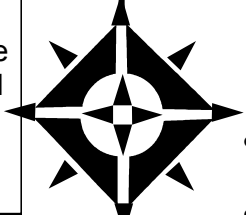
**Christmas Offering:
