Post It- B Write a prayer and place it in the bowl for private prayer

Pillar Prayer Stand with one of the historic prayers posted on one of the pillars

Sung Prayer Join in singing the simple prayer song (or just listen!)

Silent Prayer Enjoy moments of silent reflection

Sharing the Feast All are invited to the Lord's Table. Come to the table with 2-3 others, or come and wait for others to join you. Serve one another with words of your one choosing, or the words provided at the table
