God is with me; God will be with me; Always!

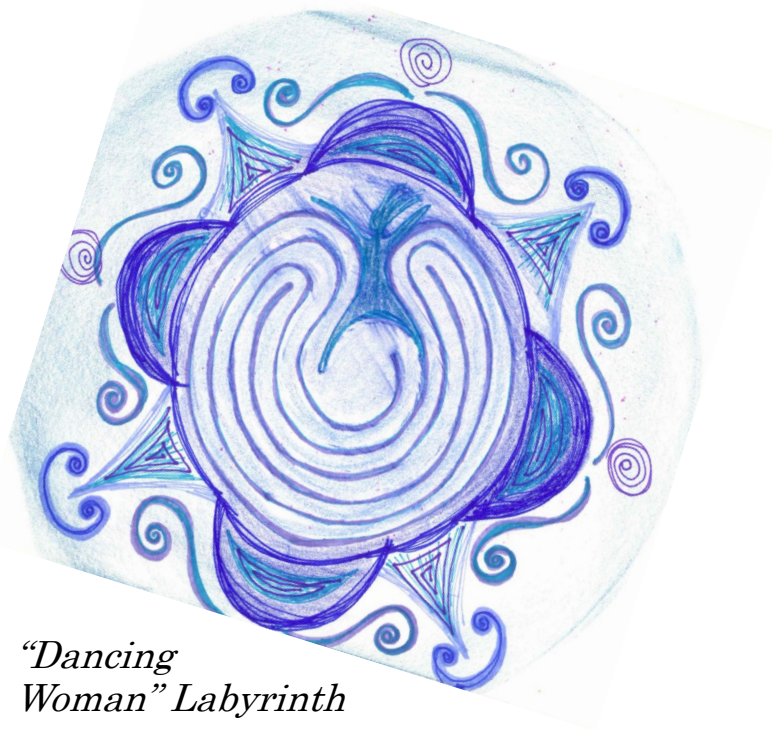
Find my way back into the world

This unique design offers the opportunity for two parties to walk, using separate entrances and seeking reconciliation in the center. Walk another's path for deeper understanding.

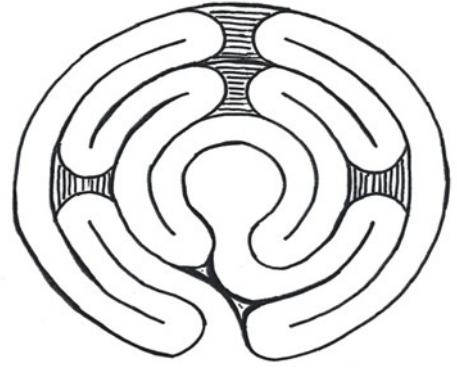

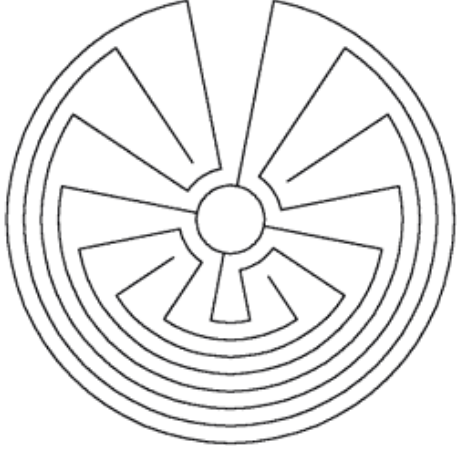
This is a smaller version of the classic design found in the Chartres Cathedral in France, a sacred pilgrimage destination for labyrinth enthusiasts throughout the world.

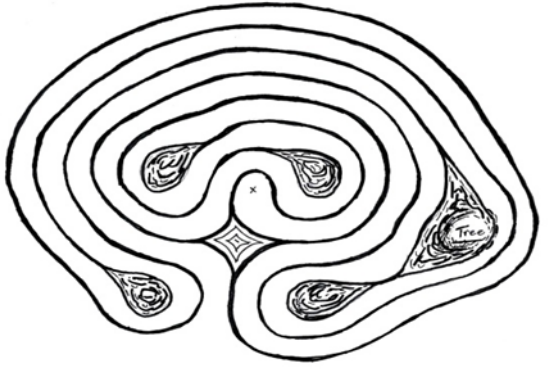
Life Choices and Harmony

It has been adopted by other people because it is significant of life's cycles and eternal motion and also of the choices we are confronted with. The right choices lead us to a point of harmony with all things, no matter how hard or long the road taken.
